on COVID-19's Effect on County Schools and Suggested Measures For Schools
to Implement
Fabio Robles represented Sarah Supahan for TCOE. He told the Board that TCOE is
waiting for guidance from the Governor. He reported that Sarah Supahan is doing
daily updates to school administrators and is getting input from the Districts to make
sure all needs are being met. Jaime Green complimented TCOE on being in contact
with State officials and passing the information on to the Districts. Jim Morey praised
TCOE on their always updated web page.

Jaime Green said the District has to make plans to both open the school back up and
also to make plans in case the schools are not opened up. He stressed the District is
here to teach kids, he wants the school to not just do enrichment but to also grade the
work given to students. Green said, "It is incorrigible to not grade students, students
need to be ready to move up to a new class next year."
Katie Poburko told the Board that her teachers are checking in with parents and
students daily, she stressed the need to not stress out students, parents and teachers.
